## **History**

22/12/1980: Launched.

Delivered on september 26, 1981 to Société nationale des chemins de fer(SNCF), Calais, France. The then ship's name was COTE D'AZUR.

28/09/1981: berthing trials at Dover.

29/09/1981: Madain trial trip on Calais-Dover line with a further trip from Boulogne to Dover.

7/10/1987: Madain commercial trip on Calais-Dover line but prevented by a strike.

1/12/1987: Visted the pool of London.

5/08/1982: Collided with Chantilly 4 miles off Calas. As damages were important(the bow visor especially), the ship was sent to Ziegler Yard, Dunkerque for repairs

11/08/1982: Resumed sailings as a stern loader only.

10/1982: Annual overhaul with bow visor repairs.

20/12/1982: Resumed sailings on Calais-Dover line.

6/1985-8/1982: Set on Boulogne/Calais-Dover line.

01/01/1986: Last sailing on Dover-Boulogne line.

2/01/1986: Set on Dover-Calais line.

22/01/1990: Registered to Société propriétaire des navires (SPN), based in Paris but the ship remains homeported in Calais. At the same time 49% of ferry operations were sold to Stena Line Ltd, London, England.

1/01/1996: Transferred to SEAFRANCE, aftern Stena Line and S.N.A.T agreement expired on december 31, 1995.

1/1996: Rebuilding at le Havre with extra passengers facilities added.

2/1996: Renamed SEAFRANCE RENOIR and re-introduced on Calais-Dover line.

1997: Side sponsons are added to fit new stability regulations.

30/11/2001: Laid-up in Dunkerque.

18/01/2002-3/2002: Set on Calais-Dover line.

3/2002: Laid-up again, to be used only in a reserve capacity.

2003: Back as a full time roster on Dover-Calais line.

9/04/2005: Laid-up in Dunkerque.

9/2005: Replaced SEAFRANCE MANET on the full time roster.

13/10/2005: Arrival at Dunkerque, rumoured to have been sold.

3/01/2006: Finally she resumed her sailings on Calais-Dover line.

30/11/2006-24/12/2006: Annual refit at les ARNO, Dunkerque.

27/12/2007: As Seafrance purchased the new JEAN NICOLI from SNCM, it was annouced that the new ship will replace Seafrance Renoir and Seafrance Manet.
